## Volodymyr Mula

filmmaker, producer, sports reporter, journalist and TV host

Volodymyr Mula was born October 22, 1989 in Horodenka, Ivano-Frankivsk region, Ukraine.

In 2006, Mula graduated the Horodenka Gymnasium with Gold medal. In 2006–2012 he studied at the Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute and received a master's degree.

From 2007-2009 he worked as a computer administrator and website content manager at the Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute.

In 2009 he founded and worked as the editor-in-chief of website TeleProstir.com and as a special reporter at Mediasat.



In 2012 he worked as a special reporter on Marketing Media Review magazine.

In 2014 he produced the LiveTime TV show and live broadcasts of the Eurovision song contest and worked as special reporter of "1+1" and Radio Lvivska Hvyla during 2014 FIFA World Cup in Brazil.

From 2014-2016 he was a TV Host, reporter and producer of Hromadske Sport Show.

Mula is the author of a series of reports on Rio de Janeiro and the infotainment project Around the Baltic States.

In 2015 Mula shot American Dream, a documentary about immigrants from post-soviet countries in United States. The film depicts a Ukrainian journalist's trip in a long-haul truck. It covered 11 American states, two oceans, two borders, 10 000 km of roads and yielded 350 gigabytes of footage.

In 2016 he worked as special reporter on the BBC Ukrainian Service during Euro 2016 in France and 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio.

He filmed the sequel: <u>American Dream. In Search of Truth</u>, a feature documentary. In it, he used the stories of eight people to show paths of self-realization under varying fields and conditions.

In 2018 he was a special reporter on ICTV during the PyeongChang 2018 Winter Olympics.

From 2018-2020 Mula is working on "UKE", a documentary about NHL players with Ukrainian roots.
